Activities in the session 2017-18

1. Tree Plantation in College Premise (3/07/2017)

On 3 July 2017 Tree Planation was jointly organised by the college NSS unit and Bouddha Mahasabha, North Nagpur Cluster. 10 volunteers of NSS unit of the college participated in this Tree Plantation



2. Three Days Camp for New Voters Registration (21 to 23 July 2017)

On behalf of NSS a three days New Voters Registration camp was conducted between 21.0717 to 23-07-17 in the college premises for the staff and students. This activity was organized under the aegis of Election Wing of District Collector office. Sri. Bavankar and his team was invited for the same. 630 students from graduate and post graduate classes were enrolled as new voters in this camp.

So as a part of social responsibility a three Days Sickle Cell Screening Camp was organised in association with Sickle Cell Acssociation , Indira Gandhi ,Govt.Medical College, Nagpur between 25 Sept to 28 Sept,2017 in the college auditorium . Dr. Anuradha Shrikhande, Dean, Sickle Cell Unit, IGMC, Dr. Vicky Ramteke and their team successfully conducted the camp. The camp was inaugurated at the hands of Dr. Shrikhande . 330 students from UG and P.G classes were screened to detect the disease.
