

Therefore, students reaches library for resources and for reading room access. The changed features in Library now, the attendance of students is recorded through QR code on smart Phones. The time spent by the students or staff members is recorded online. The Library management is trying to enhance the library attendance through different activates and engagement of students.

College has subscribed INFLIBNET and all students and teachers are its user. Therefore, both students and teachers are exposed to digital world created by the Government of India.

Library also has Network Resource centre where students can access library resources and resources through INFLIBNET.

Librarian and faculties in the college orient students for DOAJ Open Access sites for free access to worldwide digitalized books.

Library has a OPAC system where students can get information of library resources. Since issue and return of books is digitized through bar code system, it consumes no time for students.

Library is fully automated so students can access library resources on their smart phones, therefore, it becomes easier to library user to get their required book in time.

Library has spacious Students reading sections where students can spend long hours for reading and their examination study. Library opens at 7.15 am so students can access reading room from morning till 5.00 pm. During examination library hours are usually increased up to 8.00 pm.

Library has subscribed e-journals and kept many journals information on Library system Library staff help students in accessing the e-resources through the Network resource centre which is opened for entire day and students can access it without any charges.
