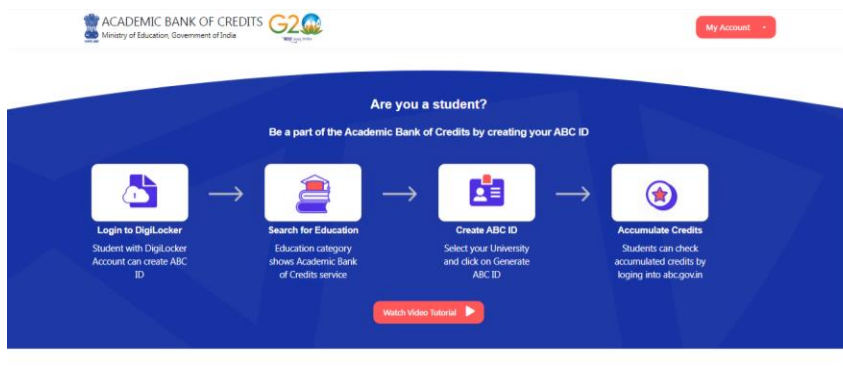
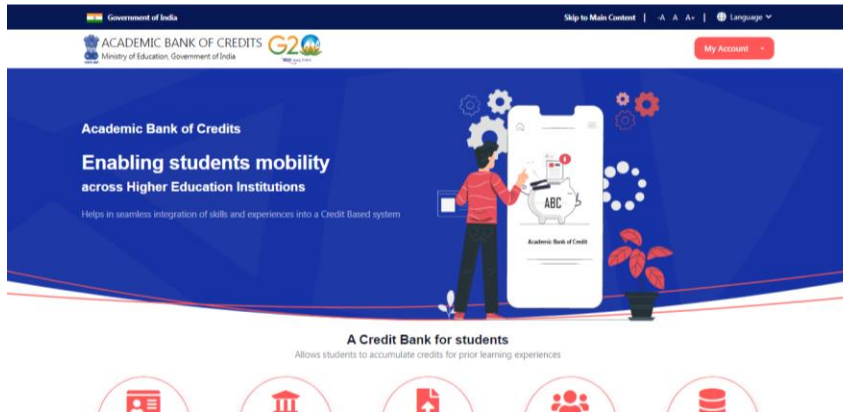

Step 1: Visit the Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) portal — [abc.gov.in](https://www.abc.gov.in/).

Step 2: On the home page, click on the link for 'my account' available on the right side top corner, and choose 'student' option.

Step 3: You will be redirected to a new window. Login/register using your username/mobile number or government-issued identification cards.

Step 4: Key in all the required information and upload documents, if needed.

**Subject: Implementation of Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) at the University level**

Respected Madam/Sir,

As you are aware, National Education Policy, 2020 envisions the establishment of the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC), a national-level facility which will be a bank for academic purposes with students as academic account holders. ABC shall provide a variety of services which include credit verification, credit accumulation, credit redemption and authentication of academic awards.

For the effective implementation of this student-centric facility, it is essential that all universities with approval from their statutory authorities/amendment of extant ordinances, register with the ABC and monitor the development and operationalization of the ABC programme at the university level. Further, it will encourage and make it possible for all students to open an academic bank account with ABC to commute credits to award any degree/diploma/certificate.

In this connection, it is informed that Prof. M. Jagadesh Kumar, Chairman, UGC will discuss the operationalization of the ABC at the universities on **December 29, 2022 (Thursday), at 10:00 AM**. The National e-Governance Division (NeGD) of the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) will share the end-to-end flow of the ABC and guide on the subject.
