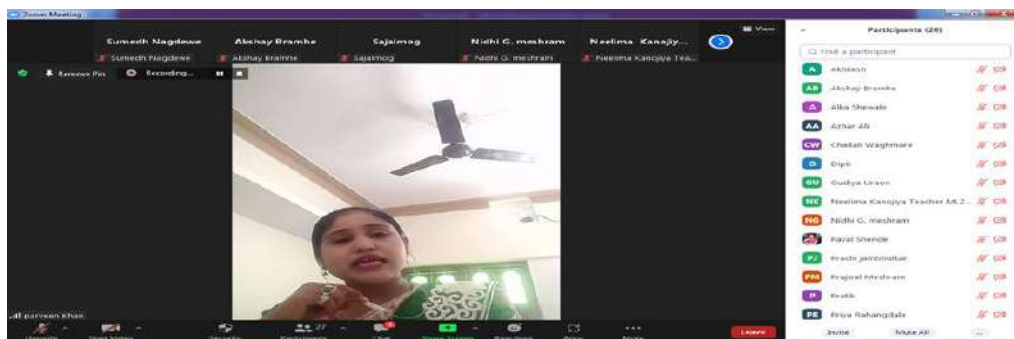
4. Visit to Library

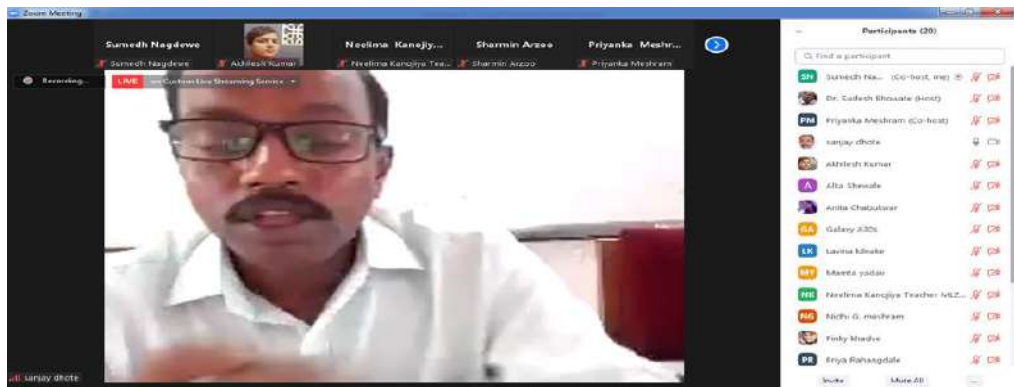
5. Workshop on NET/SET:

Department of Political Science:

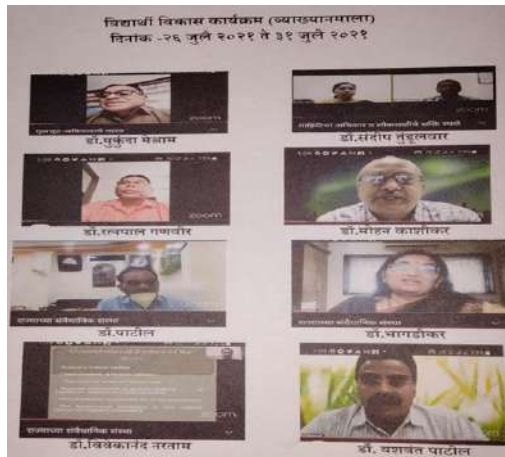
1. National Voting Day:

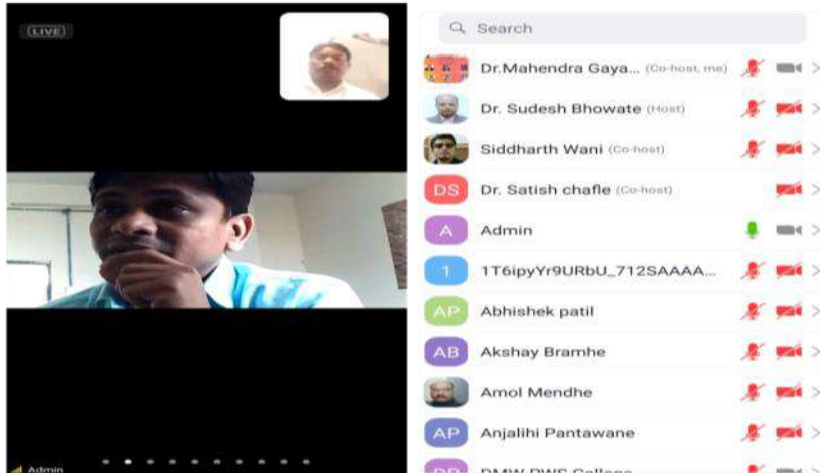
4. Participation in Elocution Contest.

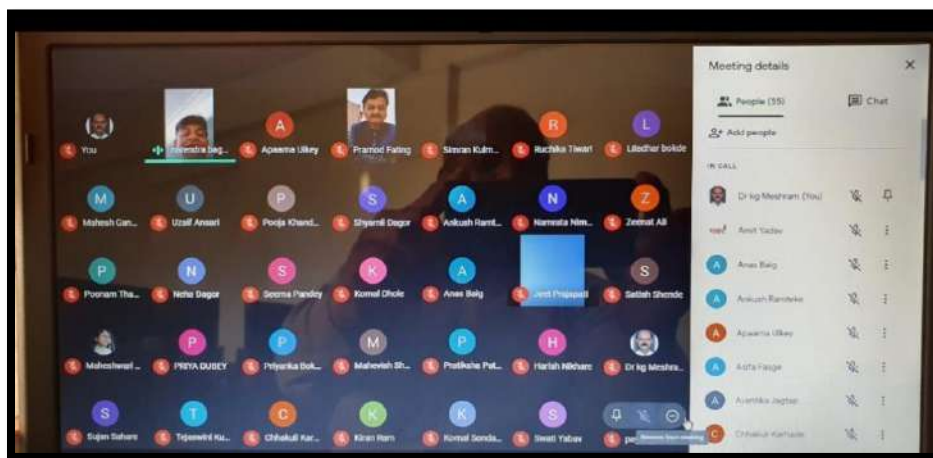
10. Visit to “Government Post Office, Nagpur ”- 05/05/2022

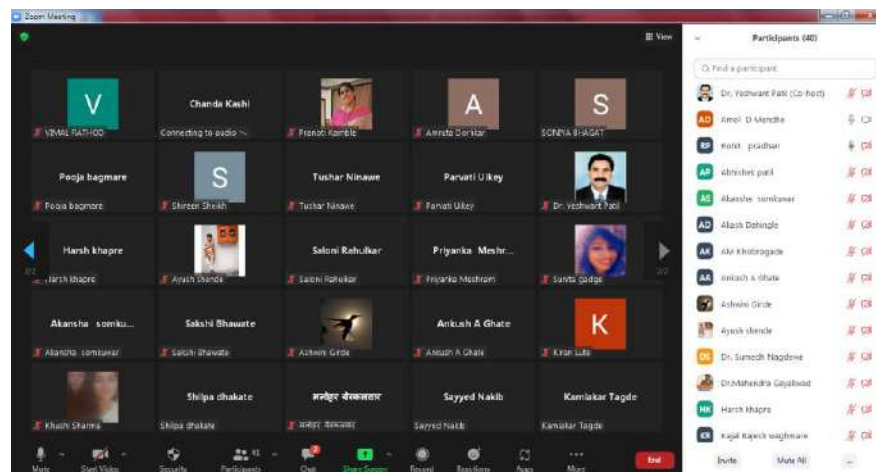

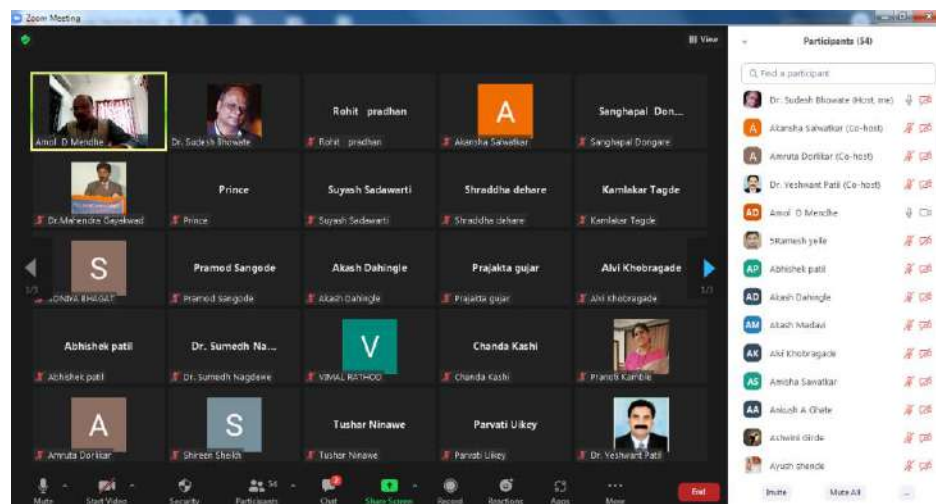

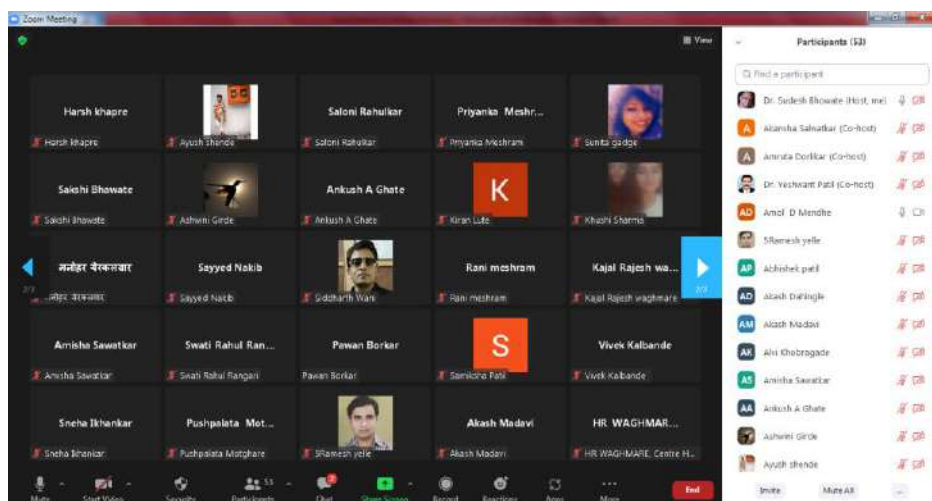

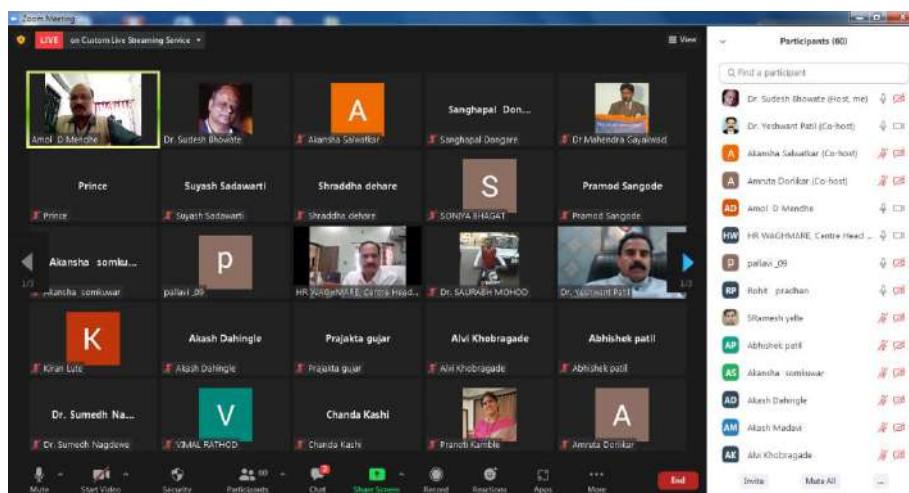

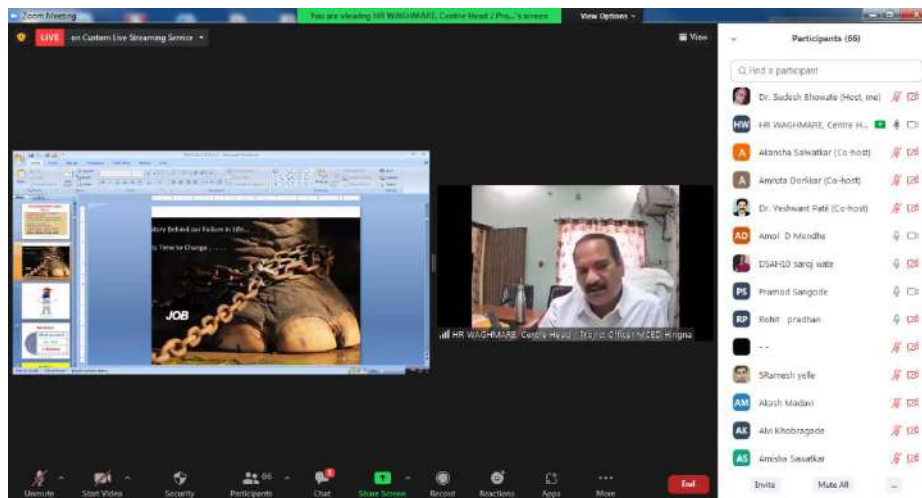

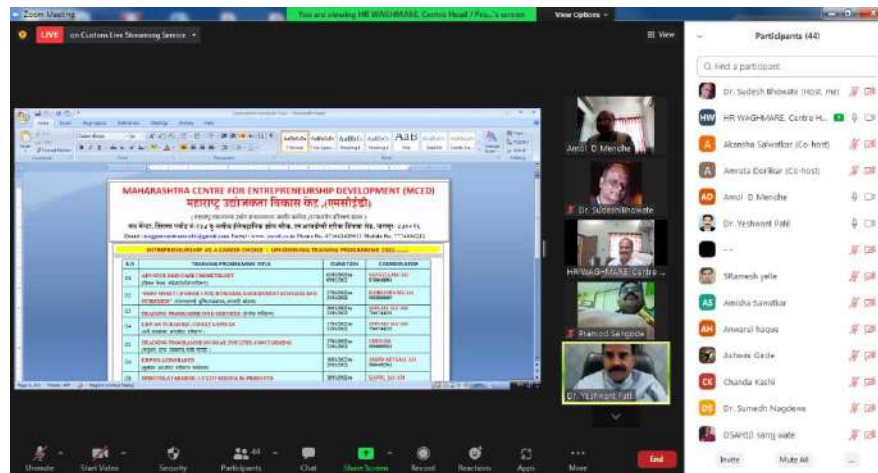

Complaints received from students.

The complaints from B. Com I Sem, Hindi medium students Riya Chikate, Komal Banyar, and Shivani Jambhulkar was that students do not understand the teaching of the English teacher also their course is not completed. So, they request to change another teacher.

This should be seriously considered.

2. Regarding the demand of girls' common room: -

The complaints of B.A III Sem was that they demand to provide common room to take a rest when their classes are off.

Action Taken

24/12/2021

In reference to the complaint of students received by Grievance Redressal Cell on 25/05/21 the following actions have been taken.

The committee has received a complaint from Abhishek Chahande (B.A Sem- I) regarding the exam result. The committee immediately contacted the student and checked all the exam result records of the college and filed an online complaint (appeal) to the university. In this way the problem of the student was resolved.

All the teachers have been instructed to send notes on the Whats App group and all the teachers have followed the instructions and sent the notes to the students.

After receiving the complaint from the student Akshay Walde regarding the Pali Literature exam schedule. The Committee informed Dr. Pranoti Kamble, Head of Department Pali to send the exam timetable schedule.

Addressing a complaint regarding borrowing books and notes from the library, the librarian was instructed to give books and notes to the B. A. first semester student Fatima.

All the teachers and librarians have been instructed to attend the complaints of the students and resolve them on priority basis.

Internal Academic Audit Report (2021-2022)

Like every year the exercise of Internal Academic audit was conducted in the last week of April. Internal Academic Audit committee received the Teachers Profile, Annual Departmental Reports and Committee Reports from the IQAC Coordinator of the College. The committee members gathered during visit schedules and time to time evaluated the Teachers Profile and departmental and committee reports. The meeting of the committee was organized on 11th April 2022 and the schedule of the visit was prepared from 18/04/2022 to 21/04/2022.

Committee members evaluated the works of the departments, Committees and administrations sections on the basis of the Department activity Reports, Dept. files and Records maintained by the concerned department. Evaluation of Admin record was done by personal visits to the respective sections. During the consultation of the documents a healthy discussion amongst the committee members and the concerned members of department was done towards the minimum required standard for the fulfillment of the duties both by teaching and non-teaching staff.

The internal Academic Audit was conducted in the month of April 2022. A special format "Teachers Profile" designed to measure the overall involvement and performance of the teaching faculty in the terms of academic upgradation of academic and professional competence. The teachers also informed about any issues with the fulfilment of the minimum standard. Mainly they were prompted to publish the research papers in UGC CARE listed and SCOPUS indexed journals only. Teachers were also advised to participate in Faculty Development Programmes conducted by UGC HRDC for upgrading ICT knowledge. Teachers who haven't undertaken any research projects and publish meagre research papers they were suggested to fulfill the requirement of research credentials.

On the other hand, during the departmental and admin section visits for the evaluation of the work done by the staff, lacunas and weaknesses were pointed out and same were discussed with the concern employees. A visit was paid to administrations sections including admission section, scholarship section, account section, External exam section, and Library.

The record of all admin sections were verified and wherever necessary they were asked to update the record. The confidential notes were also prepared to be shared with the Principal. Through this process and interaction, the various lapses and lacunas in infrastructural and academic grounds were pointed out.

The Committee members visited personally each department and took a review of departmental files and documentations as follows.

The Internal Academic Audit Report for under-graduation Courses in Arts & Commerce as well as ten PG Departments was prepared by the Committee. The Committee convened different meetings with the teaching staff to bring about the improvement in the teaching learning experience and to make it more fun loving and enriching for the students.

The committee reports which submitted to college IQAC were examined by the Internal Academic Audit committee. The weaknesses were pointed out and conveyed to the concerned committee conveners. Some committee conveners were called for personal interaction and they were prompted for the missing activities by the department.

Since the college IQAC Coordinator and Co-coordinators were the part of the Internal Audit Committee, various lacunas were noted down and decided to overcome all those issues in the following session. The report is submitted to the Principal for the further appropriate action.
