

2. Kitchen Kit Distribution Program by Extension Cell (Dt- 20/09/2020)



Through Sankalp, a social organization, morning and evening meals were distributed in sealed containers for 2 months in North Nagpur. A total of 20 volunteers worked hard in it. 5. Polio Vaccination Awareness Campaign (Dt.-17/01/2021)

National Immunization Day is conducted in the name of Pulse Polio Vaccination. National Polio Immunization Drive (Pulse Polio Immunization Drive). Under this, all children up to five years of age will be given polio vaccine. Meanwhile, the National Immunization Day was to begin from January 17. However, since the Covid-19 Vaccination Drive started from January 16, the polio vaccination drive was suspended. But as per the directives of the government, the awareness rally was organized by the NSS of the college. In consultation with the Office of the President of India, the Ministry of Health decided to start Polio Vaccination Day from 31st January. This day is also known as National Immunization Day or Polio Sunday. A team of NSS from the college took out a polio awareness rally in the local area and spread the message of polio free India.
