#### 6.3.5 Performance Appraisal System for teaching and Non-teaching staff

For the smooth process of placements and promotions of the Teaching and Non-teaching staff College has adopted the system released by the UGC, Government of Maharashtra and RTM Nagpur University, Nagpur.

#### For teaching Staff:

Teacher has to fulfill the criteria for the career advancement scheme applicable for the affiliated colleges. A teacher has to perform on three different level i.e. teaching learning, Research Publication and administrative role in his duties during the sessions under his placement tenure.

**Annual Teacher's Profile:** To access the annual performance college IQAC has developed a form for a teacher i.e. teacher's profile. The profile is develop to get input for NAAC works and may it be support to PBAS documentation.

**Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS):** A form is developed by the Government of Maharashtra & RTM Nagpur University for the placement procedure of the teachers. The proforma is compulsory to all teacher in each category.

**PBAS Proforma for Promotion under CAS:** The proforma is applicable for the placement of Associate Professor and Professor

**Confidential Form:** A teacher has to submit a confidential form which has three parts. The first part is filled by the teacher, second part is to be filled by the head of the department and the third part is to be filled by the principal. Principal's remarks vary from Excellent, Very Good, Good, Satisfactory or Unsatisfactory.

**Feedback Form:** College annually receives feedback from the college teaching staff to look into quality improvements in the campus experience.

#### **Placement Process:**

- 1. The placement slots are 6 years for first placement of Asst. Professor, (4 years for Ph D holder), next five years for the second placement of Asst. Professor, next three years for the placement of associate professor, and another three years for the placement of Professor is generally applicable here.
- 2. A teachers has to submit application to The principal for his placement process
- 3. The teacher is asked to prepare his placement file and produce his PBAS/CAS proforma with adequate research score.
- 4. To scrutinize the file and for validate the claims made by the applicant for his placement, principal appoints a screening committee and IQAC Coordinator. In the Screening committee two senior teachers have been appointed to evaluate the placement file.
- 5. The satisfactory completion of the scrutineer process in the college, the Principal engages his admin staff to online process of the teacher's application to RTM Nagpur University, College section.

- 6. University send a committee of experts including Chairman, Two Vice-chancellor's nominee, and two Subject expert.
- 7. With the committee from University, Principal sends an application to Joint Director of Higher education for the JD Nominee
- 8. With the JD Nominee's approval a placement date is decided and all the members are invited for the placement meeting where the members evaluate the teacher's performance during the period of placement through the file prepared by the applicant.
- 9. Fir the first two placement it is only a screening of the work done by the member is applicable whereas for the placement of Associate Professor and Professor a proper interview is conducted. A teacher is supposed to give his presentation and answer the questions of the interview panel.
- 10. With the satisfactory answer members signed the minutes of the placement and finalized the file for further processing of approval by RTM Nagpur University and Joint Director of Higher Education, Nagpur Division.
- 11. After approval process successfully completed a revised scle of placement is given to the beneficiary teacher.

#### For Non-Teaching Staff:

A placement of non-teaching staff is done after 12 years and 24 years for placement increments. College first take an approval form the Joint Director of Higher education, and then promotion measures are applied. College will give promotion to the senior most non-teaching staff of the college.

The promotion is done on the availability of the vacant post only.

If the post is vacant college has to take an approval from the Joint Director of higher education. The post is scrutinized for the category and accordingly it is filled.

A non-teaching staff is supposed to submit **his Feedback form and confidential form** annually which help the administrator to consider the name of employee for the possible promotions.
