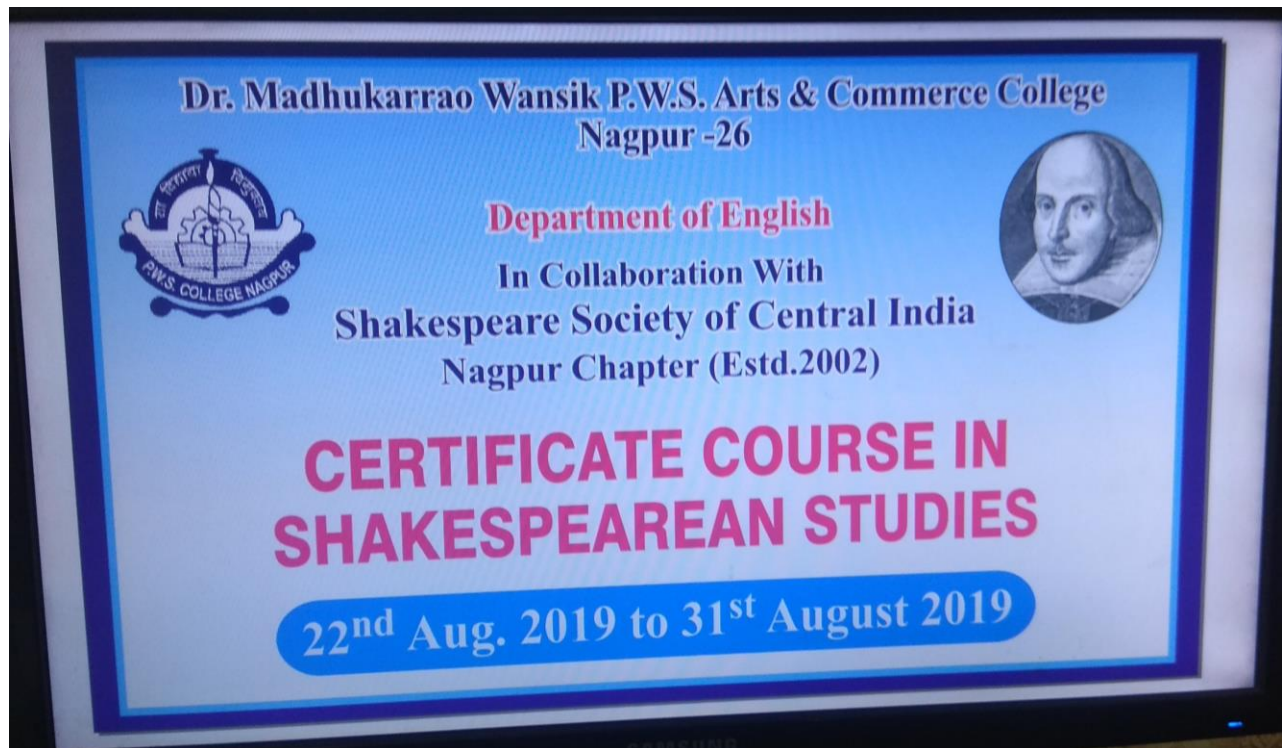

A Report on Certificate Course on Shakespearean Studies

William Shakespeare stands as a global figure in English language. He has enriched the world literature with his unique, unparalleled, and undisputed craftsmanship as a dramatist and poet. Shakespeare was a great literary giant who had influenced every field of art, culture, and literature.

Department of English of Dr. Madhukarrao Wasnik PWS Arts and Commerce College organized a Shakespeare Certificate Course in collaboration with Shakespeare Society of Central India, Nagpur Chapter from Aug 22nd, 2019 to Aug 31st, 2019. The course was formally inaugurated on the 22nd of August 2019 at the hands of Dr. Urmilla Dabir, Principal of Rajkumar Kewalramani College, Nagpur. Dr. Pranoti Chakerbutty, President of Shakespeare Society of Central India (SSCI), Nagpur Chapter was the Key-note Speaker on the occasion. She delivered an erudite lecture on "Introduction to Shakespeare". Dr. Usha Sakure, Secretary, SSCI took the participants on a virtual journey to Shakespeare's birthplace and the Globe Theatre with her power point presentation. The inaugural session was chaired by the principal of the college, Dr Yashwant Patil

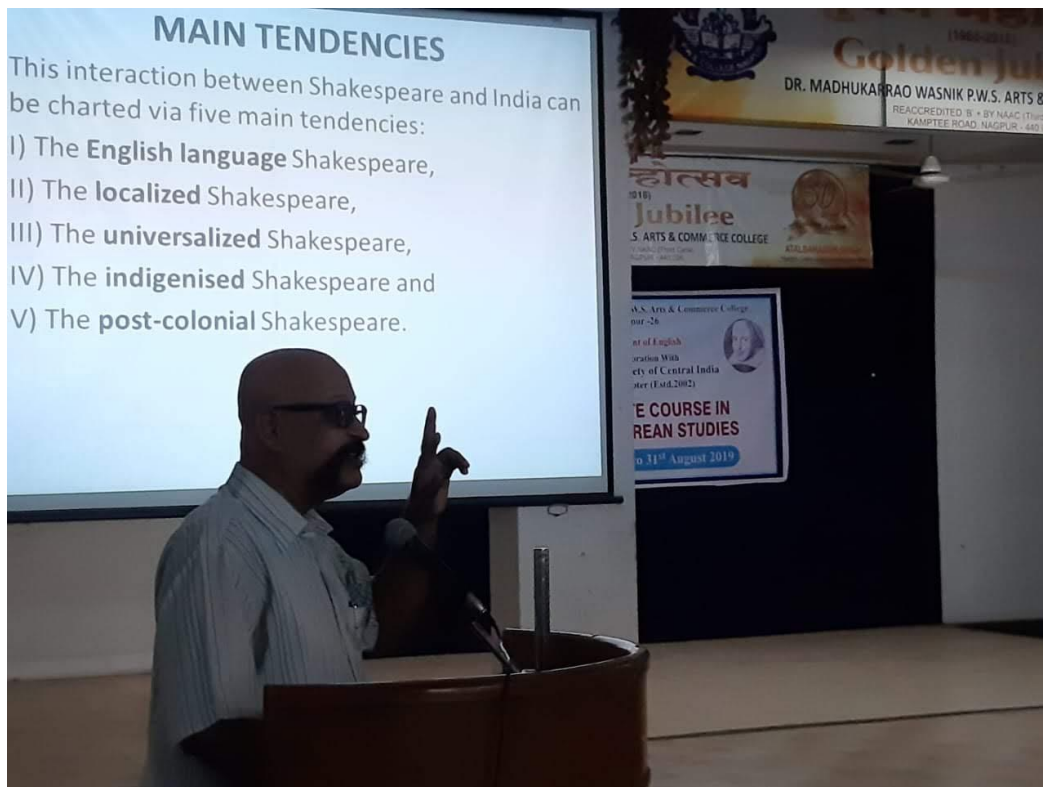






Eminent and illustrious scholars from across the city and from different colleges visited our college as Guest speakers who delivered lectures with power point presentations on varied aspects of Shakespearean Studies. The likes of Dr. Supantha Battacharya, Hislop College, Dr. Sujata Chakravarty, Dayanand College, Dr. Jyoti Patil, Renuka College, Ms. Supriya Chowdhary, Rtd. Principal of Central Point School, Dr. Manjushree Sardeshpande from Dharampeth college, Dr. Mithilesh Awasthi, PWS College, Yugal Rayulu, Bipasha Ghoshal, Dr. Sudesh Bhowate and Prof. Mahesh Dudhe, PWS College were the guest speakers.

In the first session on 23rd Aug 2019 on Friday Dr. Supantha Bhattacharya was invited as the response person dealing on the topic “Staging Shakespeare on Modern Indian Stage”. He brought out the modern adaptation on Indian stage pointing out the performances. The roles played by British actors. The adoptions in Bollywood that had all influence of Shakespeare dramatic art and genius.



During the second session Dr. Sujata Chackravorty was invited as a resource person on 24th Aug 2019 on Saturday. She conducted her presentation on “Shakespearean Tragedy with Reference to Macbeth”. During her lecture, she highlighted the different aspect or Shakespearean tragedy such as plot and characters, supernatural elements, Hamartia the tragic elements the history of the play as well as the catastrophe and poetic justice traced in her speech.



Being a resource person Dr. Megha Ramteke dealt her topic “Shakespearean Plays: Language, Phrases and Idiom”. In the second session, made her presentation on the linguistic excellence and special vocabulary used by Shakespeare in his plays and poetry.

On 26th Aug 2019 on Monday the fourth session was held by Dr. Jyoti Patil, dealing on the topic “Shakespearean Roman Plays with special reference to Julius Caesar”. She thrownligh on the Roman culture and literature with the ting of history and it influence on The Roman Plays on Shakespeare. She made detail analysis of the play Julius Caesar bringing out all the aspect of Shakespeare Roman Plays penned by Shakespeare.



Prof. Amol Mendhe as a resource person in the second session dealt on the topic “Introduction to English tragedies”. He traced the importance of features of English tragedies, its origin from Senecan tragedies and its deep influence on Elizabethan dramatist especially on Shakespeare.



Mrs. Supriya Chowdhry as a resource person in the six session of the course on 27th Aug 2019 on Tuesday spoke on the topic “Shakespeare English Language and Usage in Present day”. In her presentation, she observed and presented the influence of Shakespeare’s language in modern society. She also highlighted the relevance of Shakespeare language in the present-day scenario.



The second Prof. Mahesh Dudhe dealt on the topic “Shakespeare: Life and Time”. He provided a detail study on the universality of Shakespeare’s philosophy of life and journey of Shakespeare from mere curtain raiser to the greatest dramatist English language.

A wonderful session on Shakespeare’s sonnet was conducted by Manjushree Sardeshpande on 28th Aug 2019 on Wednesday during the course she introduced some of the important and memorable sonnets written by Shakespeare as The Rape of Lucrece and the others bringing out the artistic excellence and poetic genius of Shakespeare.



Dr. Mithilesh Awasthi conducted the second session on the “Hindi Rangamanch par Shakespeare ka prabhav”. On the same day, he traced out the influenced of Shakespeare’s dramatic art on Hindi literature and stage craft. He brought out some of the master pieces in Hindi literature highlighting Shakespearean themes and characterization.



Dr. Yugal Rayulu being a guest speaker talked on “Universality of Shakespeare” on 29th Aug 2019 on Thursday. The universal appeal and all time relevance of Shakespeare and his dramatic art and philosophy was beautiful traced through a power point presentation, bring detail analysis of all Shakespearean tragedies. The off quoted lines and passages were analyses in detail showing relevance of Shakespeare in his discourse.



Dr. Sudesh Bhowate dealt on the topic “Shakespearean Historical Plays with special reference to Henry IV” in the next session of the day. He highlighted the association of English history with Shakespeare dramatic art and culture. The influence of English historical characters was beautifully traced with special reference of Henry IV in his presentation.

In the last session, during the course Dr. Bipasha Ghoshal spoke on the topic “Women characters in the light of Shakespearean Comedies”. Dr. Ghoshal pointed out the feministic studies in Shakespearean comedies following all the characteristic of the prominent women character in his comedies.



The Film adaptations on Shakespeare's plays like Macbeth, Hamlet, Julius Caesar, Othello etc. were also screened. A test on the basis of the course was also conducted at the end of the course.

The valedictory session of the course "Certificate Course in Shakespearean Studies" was organized in the august presence of the eminent guests. Mr. Manoj Wasnik, honorable joint secretary of the People Welfare Society was invited as chief guest. Dr. Yashwant Patil, the principal of the college chaired the session. Some of the participants expressed their views about the course. All the participants were given certificate for their active participation during the course. 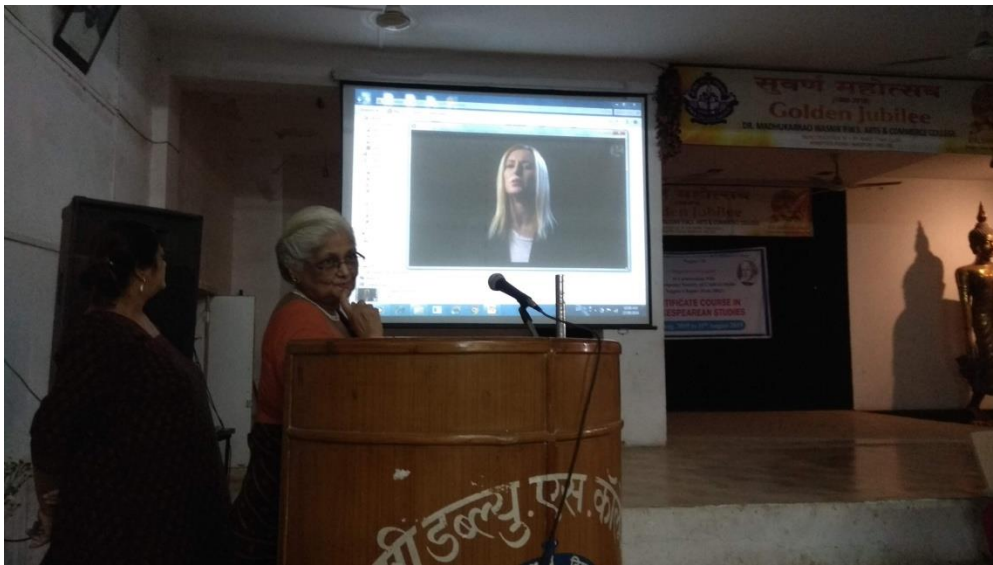

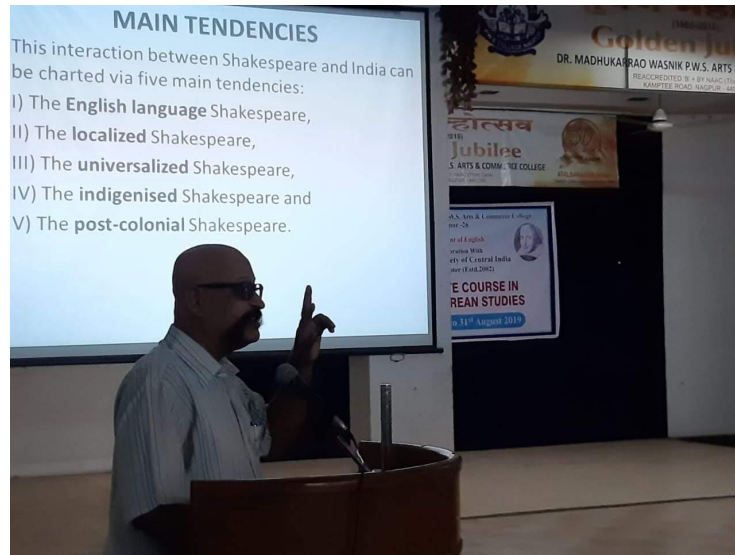

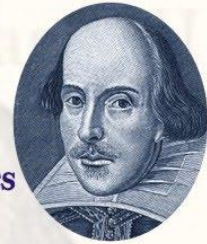
