


Report on One Day Online National Workshop on Intellectual Property Rights and Issues in Copy Rights




Dr. Sudesh Bhowate, during the inauguration of the session



Mr. Pralhad Jadhav, presenting his presentation



He discussed on different aspects of Intellectual Properties like What is a Patent, Patent Rights, Trademarks, Industrial Design, Geographical Indication, IC Layout (Semiconductor, Trade Secret, Copyright, Protection of plant verities, Farmers' Rights and Researchers' Rights). He stressed that the main purpose of intellectual property law is to encourage the creation of a wide variety of intellectual goods. He also emphasized that these property rights allow the holder to exercise a monopoly on the use of the item for a specified period. He also explained the various aspects of copy right.
