

This session included the scholarly and interesting talk by the resource Person, Mr. Pralhad Jadhav. His lecture started with the topic, 'What is Intellectual Property'. He discussed on different aspects of Intellectual Properties like What is a Patent, Patent Rights, Trademarks, Industrial Design, Geographical Indication, IC Layout (Semiconductor, Trade Secret, Copyright, Protection of plant varieties, Farmers' Rights and Researchers' Rights). He stressed that the main purpose of intellectual property law is to encourage the creation of a wide variety of intellectual goods. He also emphasized that these property rights allow the holder to exercise a monopoly on the use of the item for a specified period. He also explained the various aspects of copy right.

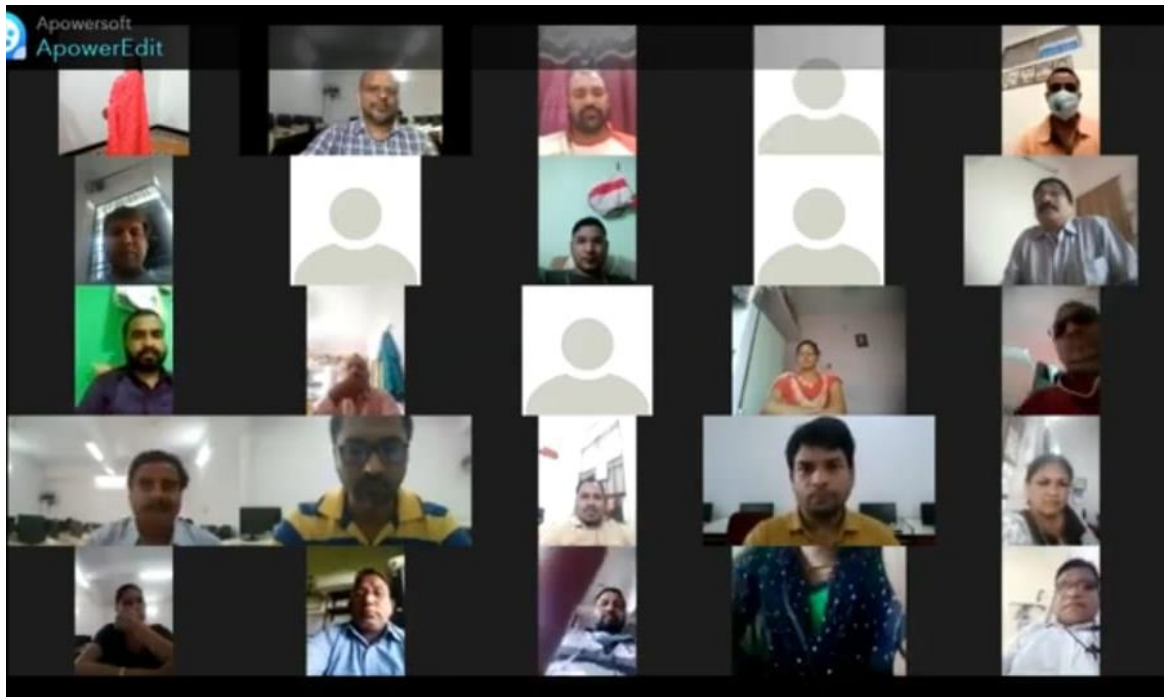
