Since 1968, there have been large number of star students passed out from the institution and set in their career. They are the real sojourners of the institution, who have made the college proud through their achievements. They are all the asset of the college and of course of the society. All such alumni who were active in sports and cultural activities, NSS activities and NCC groups, etc. brought laurels to the college through their participation in different competitions at state and national level. All such alumni time to time while they were students made the administration aware about their demands and requirements. Now these grown up students who are set in their career are still connected with their Alma matter for providing important suggestions and valuable time and in all the possible way to help the institution and the current generations of the students grow with the pace of time.

There is Milind Alumni Association ('Milind Maji Vidyarthi Sanghatana') working for many years, whose meetings have been conducted in the college regularly. To make the alumni work regularly a senior teacher works as a mediator hence he is the Alumni convener who provides reports to college IQAC and to the Principal. He is also responsible to see to it that regular meetings of the alumni is being conducted. 4. The workspace of the committee will be limited
5. From 1st April to 31st March will be the period of financial calculations
6. The membership will be cancelled if the registration fee is outstanding, the member remains absent in the meeting for three times continuously, disciplinary action is taken against college, any member being guilty of crime, 2/3 votes can the cancel of the membership.
7. A general meeting will be held once a year. Budget and future plans will be designed by the college.
8. The presence of 2/3 members is mandatory to constitute the quorum
9. In the constituent body of the organization there will be one president, one vice president one secretary, one joint secretary, one treasurer and four members
10. The tenure of the executive board will be for 5 years. After that new members will be elected on the basis of majority of votes given in confidential election.

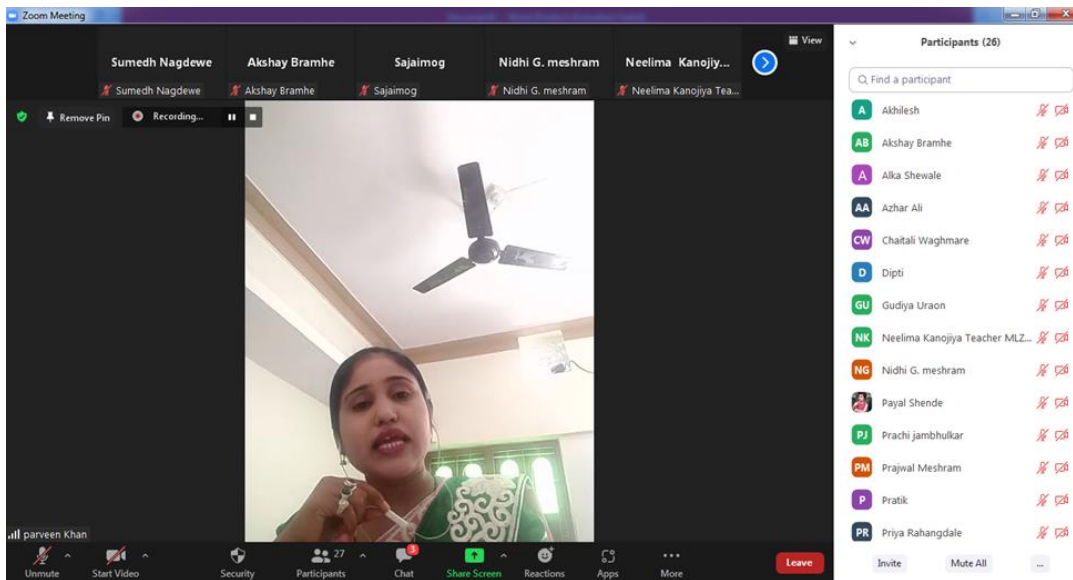
Alumni Meet:

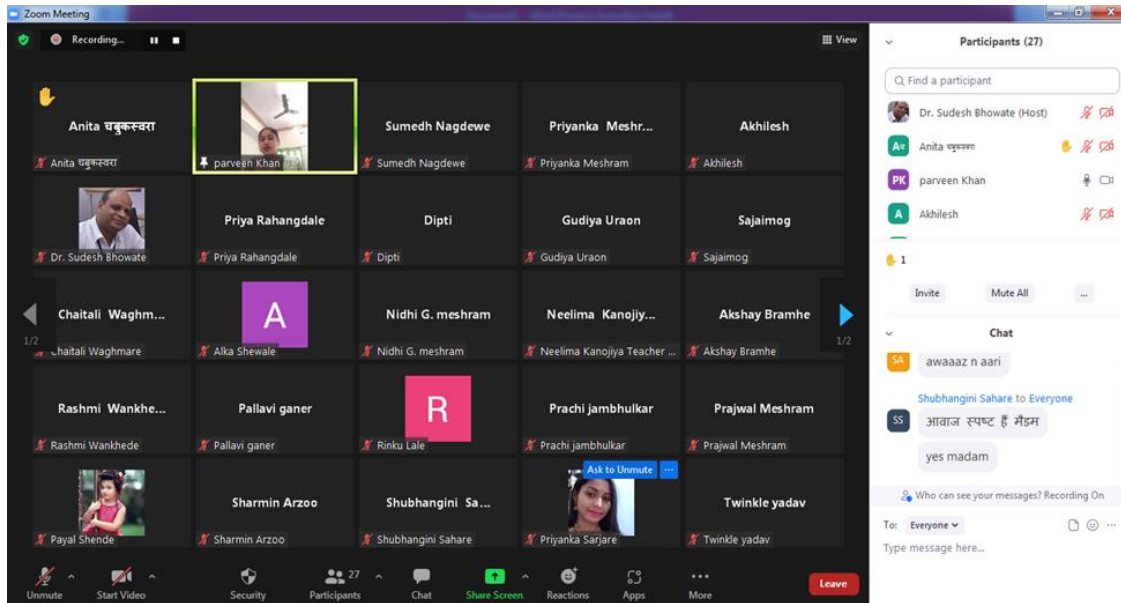


Dr. Y. V. Patil, Principal, addressin at the Alumni Meet on 16/4/22

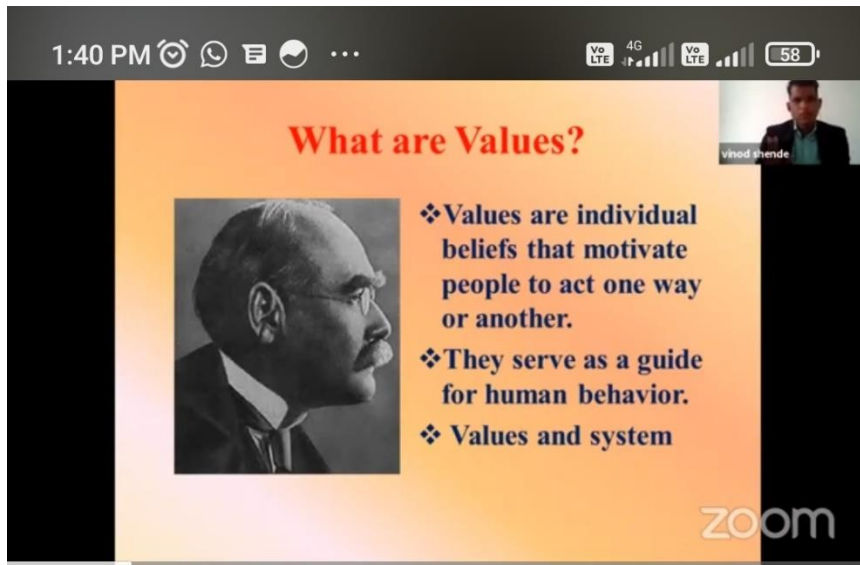


Mr. Javed Akhtar National Kabaddi Player being felicitated and addressing the audience

Ashwin Sangolkar, Alumnus of Dept of English invited as an inaugurator of a value added course

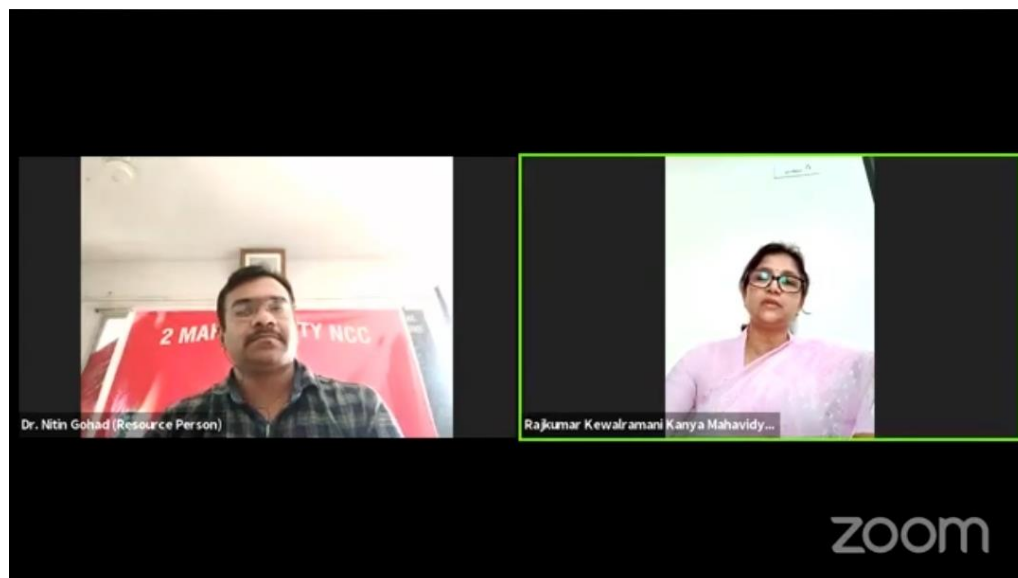

Nitin Gohad Alumnus of Dept of English invited as a Guest speaker

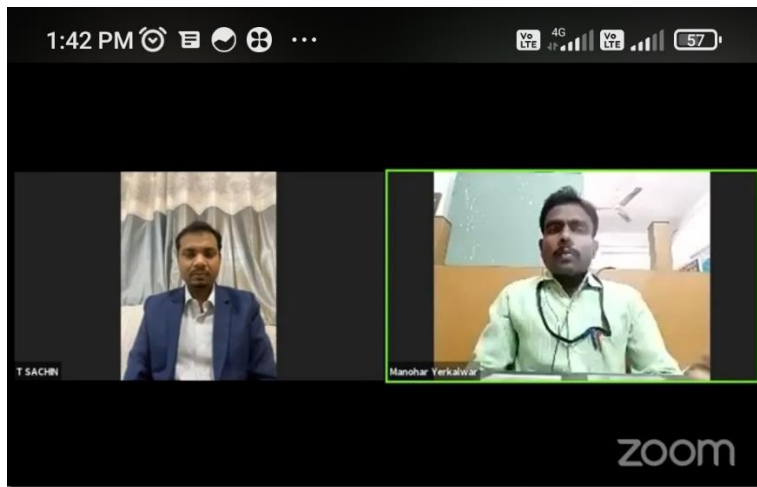

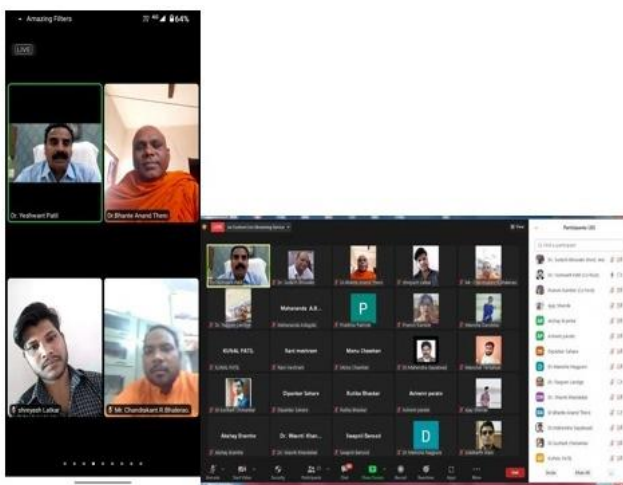

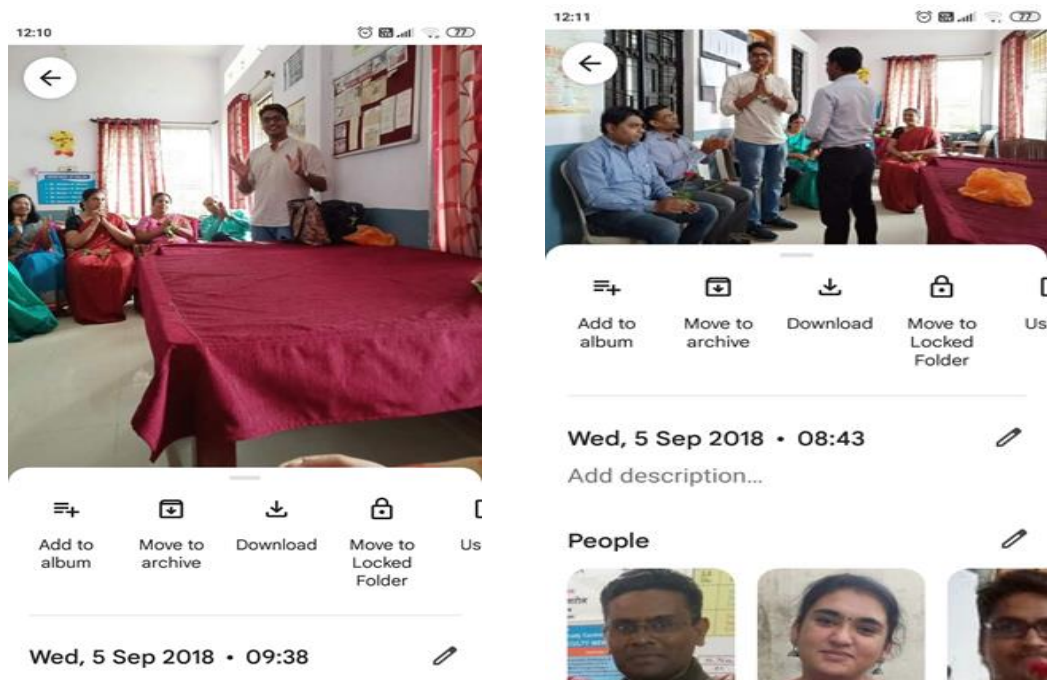

Alumni Work Report-2018-19

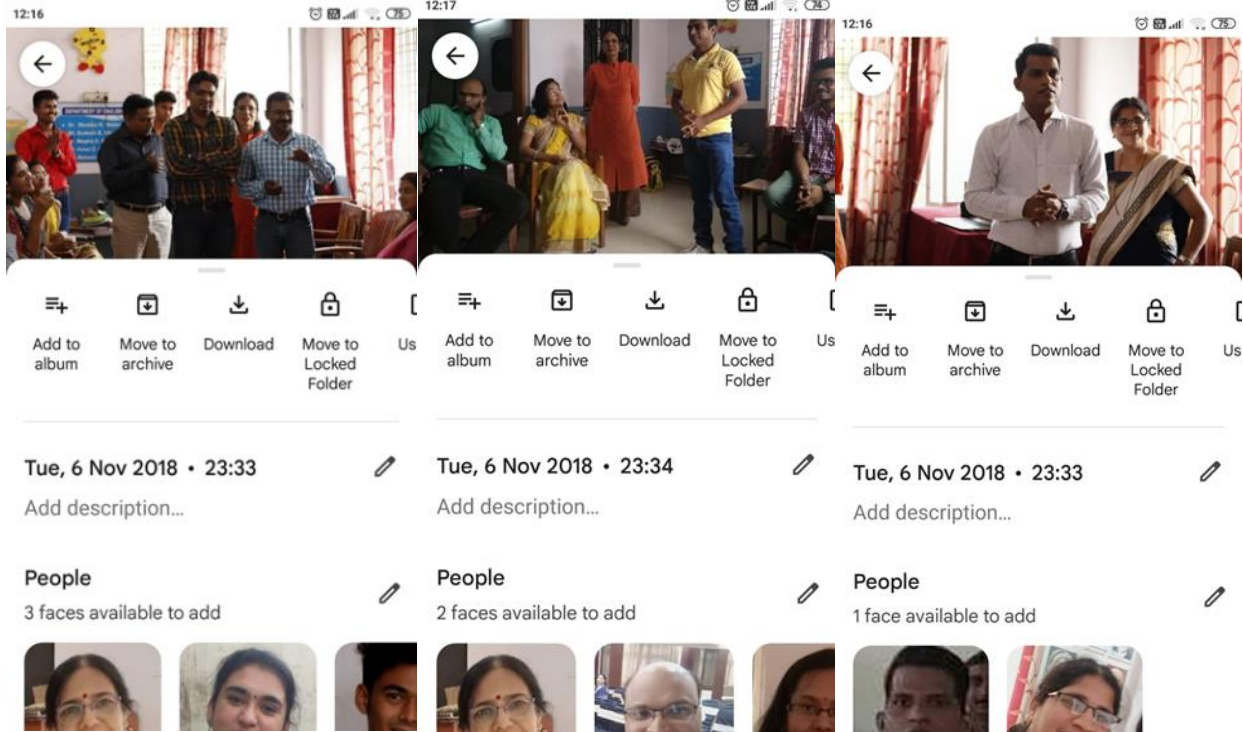
Alumni Interaction:
