1. Public awareness regarding information about government schemes (Dt-15/08/2021)

Dr. Madhukarrao Wasnik P.W.S College of Arts and Commerce, Nagpur on behalf of the Extension Department, conducted the programme on public awareness regarding information about government schemes.
